



 SUBJECT: Award of Contract – Repair of approximately 2500 feet of 8 inch Vitrified Clay Sewer Pipe (VCP) on Levante Street in Carlsbad, CA and Piraeus Street, Encinitas, CA.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff requests that the Engineering Committee recommend that the Board of Directors:

1. Authorize the General Manager to execute a contract with SAK Construction, LLC for the purchase and installation of 2500 feet of cured-in-place-pipe (CIPP) to repair nine (9) sewer line segments, located in Levante Street in Carlsbad, CA and Piraeus Street in Encinitas, CA, in an amount not to exceed \$83,089.
2. Discuss and take other action as appropriate.

DISCUSSION:

This item was included as a tactical goal under LWD’s Fiscal Year (FY) 2011 Tactics and Action Plan.

As one of the tasks within the District’s Asset Management Master Plan’s Implementation (AMMPI), Infrastructure Engineering Corporation (IEC) has reviewed video inspections of pipelines that have been identified with little remaining life. As a result, IEC has recommended the repair of nine sewer line segments located in Levante Street in Carlsbad and Piraeus Street in Encinitas. The nine segments were all clay pipelines located in deep soil and were installed in concrete saddles. LWD staff confirmed the severity of the cracks in all nine sewer lines during follow-up video inspections.

In December, staff advertised a request for bids for the purchase and installation of 2500 feet of cured-in-place-pipe (CIPP) to be installed in accordance with LWD’s Standard Specifications. The RFP was sent directly to several firms recommended by LWD’s consultants. The bids were received by the following three firms by the December 28th deadline:

1. SAK Construction	\$83,089
2. Insituform Technologies	\$84,852
3. SanCon Engineering	\$93,557

The bids were reviewed by Rob Weber at IEC. Upon completion of IEC's review, it was recommended that SAK Construction, LLC be awarded the contract as the lowest responsive and responsible bidder. Attached please find IEC's bid review results and SAK's contractor license detail. Therefore, staff recommends that the Engineering Committee recommend that the Board of Directors award the contract to SAK Construction, LLC as the lowest responsive and responsible bidder.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The Fiscal Year 2011 Capital Asset Management – Pipeline Repair/Replacement account includes sufficient funding to cover the recommended contract amount.

PURPOSE

SAK Construction submitted the lowest bid. The following reviews have been completed:

Contractor's License: The Contractor holds a Class A General Engineering Contractor's License. The license is current and valid.

Signatures: The Contractor's Vice President signed the Vendor Information Form. The President signed a notarized affidavit indicating the Vice President has the authority to enter into contracts.

RECOMMENDATION

IEC recommends award of the contract to SAK Construction of CA, LP, based on the bid amount.
