Carlsbad, Calif. – Leucadia Wastewater District opened facilities at its El Camino Real and La Costa Avenue site to the public on Friday, November 4th. environmental learning opportunities for kids and adults at the community event. In addition, LWD provided equipment demonstrations and group tours to educate the public about recycled water.

Established in 1959, Leucadia Wastewater District collects, transports, treats and disposes of wastewater. The district provides service to approximately 60,000 customers in a 16-square-mile area that includes La Costa, Leucadia and the Village Park area of Encinitas. The district disposes of more than 4.5 million gallons of treated wastewater daily.

The district's operations feature the use of advanced technology. Pipelines are regularly video-inspected to assure that they are secure and leak free. Computer mapping systems and mathematical modeling are used to design and maintain facilities so that they work under all conditions, at all times.
