A proposal to adopt a new wastewater capacity fee ordinance with an updated fee schedule to modify the method used to calculate equivalent dwelling units (EDUs) for Accessory Dwelling Units (ADUs) and Junior Accessory Dwelling Units (JADUs). The existing capacity fee of \$5,089 per EDU is not changed. However, for JADUs and ADUs that are 500 square feet or less, capacity fees (when applicable) and sewer service fees are reduced by 75%.
