## **NOTICE INVITING BIDS**

## LEUCADIA WASTEWATER DISTRICT DIANA PUMP STATION UPGRADE PROJECT

The Leucadia Wastewater District (referred to as District or Owner) is requesting bids from qualified contractors for the Owner's Diana Pump Station Upgrade Project (Project) which includes all labor, materials, services and equipment necessary for earthwork, sheeting, shoring and bracing and installation of; architectural fencing, architectural shade structure, block walls, electrical & instrumentation improvements, ductbanks, pavement restoration. curb. gutter, and concrete flatwork. demolition of existing electrical/instrumentation controls, maintaining traffic control, maintaining sewer system in service, and returning all disturbed areas and surfaces back to pre-construction conditions or better; and all miscellaneous work as shown, specified and directed for a complete operating installation.

The Work will be at the Owner's Diana Pump Station located at the intersection of Diana Street and an alley, about 100' west of Highway 101, in the City of Encinitas, California.

Sealed Bids will be received by the Owner at the Leucadia Wastewater District, 1960 La Costa Avenue, Carlsbad, California 92009 until 2:00 p.m. (local) on Tuesday, May 13, 2025 at which time they will be publicly opened and read.

Starting Tuesday, April 8, 2025, Project documents, including Information for Bidders, General Conditions; Special Conditions; Specifications; Certificates and Affidavits; Contract; Payment Bond; Performance Bond; and Plans (collectively "Contract Documents") are on file and may be obtained at Mesa Reprographics, 5560 Ruffin Road, California line San Diego, 92123. (858) 541-1500 or on at https://mesareprographics.com/lwwd19 to view and order. The cost of Plans and Specifications is not refundable whether they are returned or not.

Bids shall be executed on the forms contained in the Contract Documents and in accordance with the instructions contained therein. Bid security, in an amount not less than ten percent (10%) of the total bid dollar amount, is required to be submitted with each bid. The bidder to whom the award is made will be required to furnish a payment bond and a faithful performance bond.

A non-mandatory, but strongly encouraged, pre-bid meeting and walk-through of the work site is scheduled for 10:00 a.m. (local) time Thursday, April 17, 2025 at the pump station located on the southeast corner of the intersection at Diana Street and an alley, facing Diana Street. The job walk will be conducted jointly by the Owner and Engineer. If you plan to attend the pre-bid meeting, please notify Ian Riffel (Owner's Project Manager) at iriffel@Iwwd.org by close of business on Wednesday, April 16, 2024.

Pursuant to Section 1771 of the California Labor Code, the successful bidder shall pay not less than the prevailing rate of per diem wages as determined by the Director of the California Department of Industrial Relations. Copies of such prevailing rate of per diem wages may be obtained from California Department of Industrial Relations (DIR), Division of Labor Statistics and Research, (415) 703-4774 or may be available at the DIR website, <u>http://www.dir.ca.gov</u>. The Contractor shall post a copy of such determination at each job site.

Bidders and all proposed subcontractor(s) must be registered with the Department of Industrial Relations in accordance with Section 1725.5 of the Labor Code at the time of the bid submittal and must continue to be registered at all times they are engaged in the performance of work on the Contract.

Pursuant to Section 22300 of the California Public Contract Code, the Contractor may substitute securities for any monies withheld by the Owner to ensure performance of the work. Procedures shall be as provided in Section 22300.

All questions relative to this project prior to the opening of bids shall be directed to the Owner's project manager. It shall be understood, however, that no Specification interpretations may be made by telephone nor may any of "or equal" items be considered for approval during the bid period. In implementing this preference, the firms must be responsible and responsive and the services, materials, or work must be of comparable quality.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive any informality or irregularity in a bid, and to make awards in the interest of the Owner.

Pursuant to the requirements under Permits and Licenses in the Information for Bidders of the bidding documents, bidders shall be Class A licensed in the classification of General Engineering Contracting as of the date of submittal of the bid documents.
